

TO FIX PHOTO KITCHEN WEBSITE LOADING ISSUES

Possible Issue:

1. Javascript is not enabled in your browser.
2. you have an older version of Internet Explorer that doesn't support Javascript.

FOR INTERNET EXPLORER:

Option 1: To allow scripting on this website only and to leave scripting disabled in the Internet zone, add <http://photokitchen.net> to the Trusted sites zone. Check out this website for instructions: <http://surfthenetsafely.com/ieseczone7.htm>

Option 2: Enable scripting for all websites.

1. On the Tools menu, click Internet Options, and then click the Security tab.
2. Click the Internet zone.
3. If you do not have to customize your Internet security settings, click Default Level. Then do step 4

If you have to customize your Internet security settings, follow these steps:

- a. Click Custom Level.
 - b. In the Security Settings – Internet Zone dialog box, click Enable for Active Scripting in the Scripting section.
4. Click the Back button to return to the previous page, and then click the Refresh button to run scripts.

FOR FIREFOX VERSION 2:

1. On the Tools menu, click Options.
2. On the Content tab, click to select the Enable JavaScript check box.
3. Click the Go back one page button to return to the previous page, and then click the Reload current page button to run scripts.

FOR FIREFOX VERSION 3:

1. Go to the menu at the top and find “Preferences”.
2. In Preferences, find the “Content” tab.
3. Under Content, check the box next to “Enable JavaScript”

FOR NETSCAPE

1. Select Edit, Preferences, Advanced
2. Click to select Enable JavaScript option.
